Dr. David Lohman



Dr. David F. Lohman is Professor of Educational Psychology at The University of Iowa. He received his doctorate in educational psychology from Stanford University in 1979. He has been on the faculty of The University of Iowa since 1981. Dr. Lohman has taught at several other universities, including the University of British Columbia, the University of Yucatan, and Leiden University.

Dr. Lohman's later research has focused on the more general construct of academic intelligence - particularly its measurement and the use of ability profiles in adapting instruction to the needs of learners. He is co-author of *The Cognitive Abilities Test* and has published numerous articles in journals and chapters in books.
