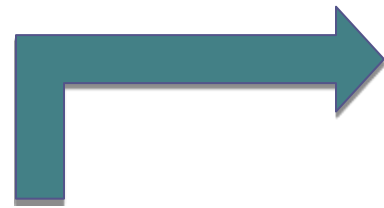
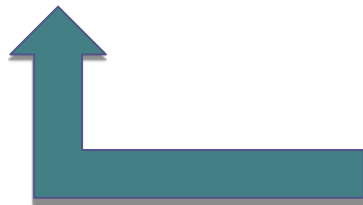

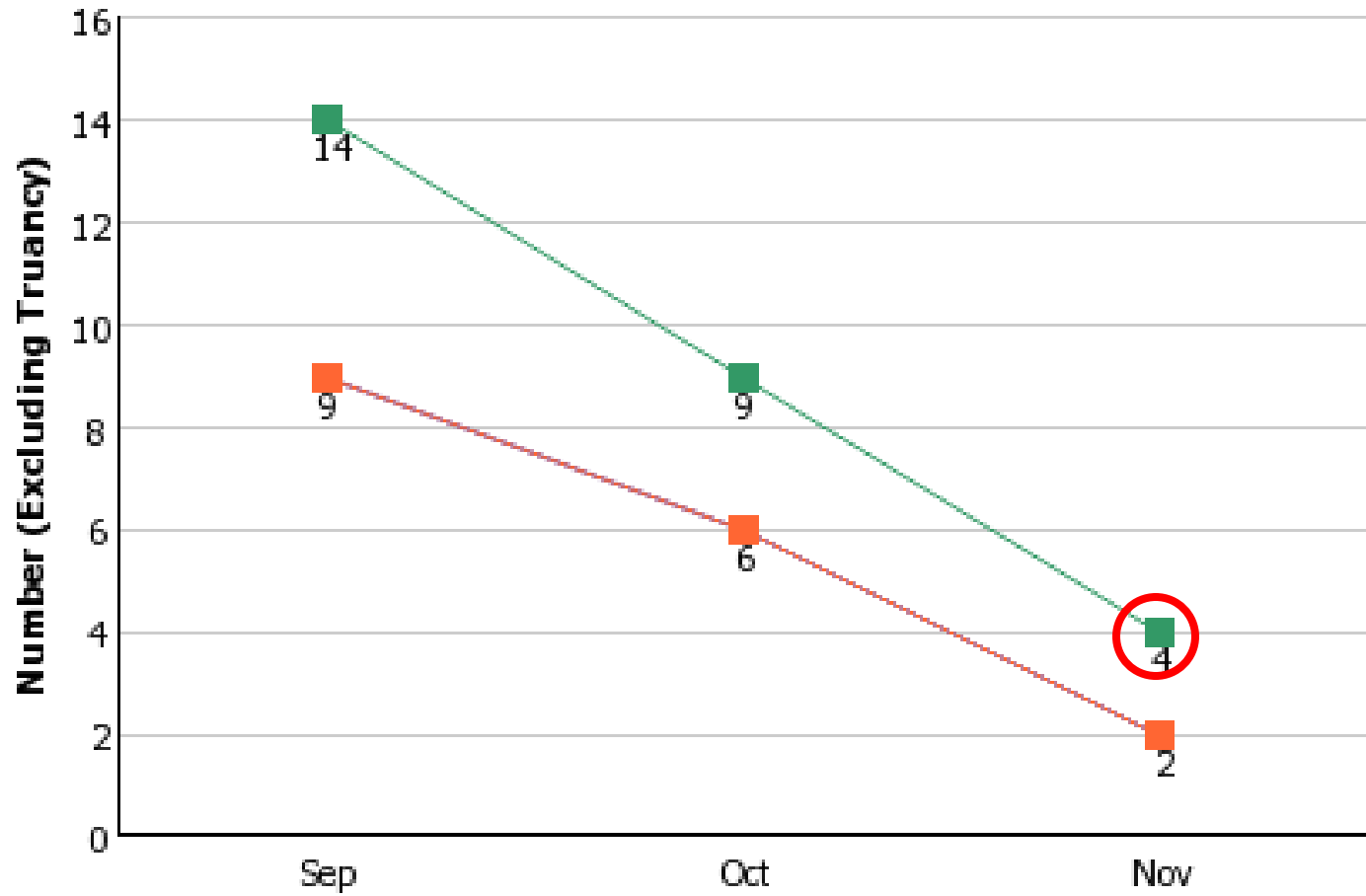
Vancouver's Data Dashboard

 - Explores - Make selections (e.g., program, term, year) to tailor the display
 - Student Search – Enter any student name or ID to see current and historical data

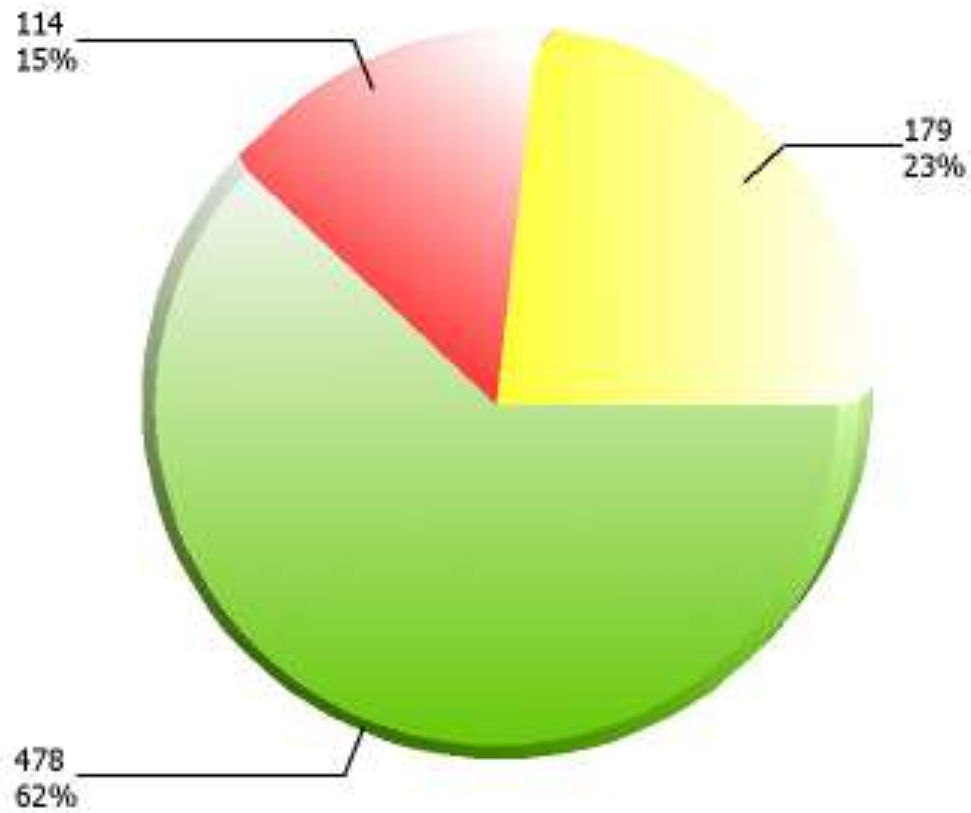
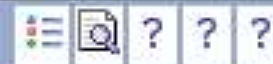
